RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned certify that:

1. They are the **president** and the **secretary**, respectively, of SAN BERNARDINO COMMUNITY AND SCHOOL ALLIANCE FOUNDATION, a California Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation.
2. The Articles of Incorporation of this corporation are amended and restated to read as follows:

I.

- A. The name of the corporation is Making Hope Happen Foundation.

II.

- A. This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes.
- B. The specific purpose of this corporation shall be to operate for educational and charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 and Section 23701(d) of the Revenue and Taxation Code of California.

III.

- A. This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable purposes, within the meaning of Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3) or the corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law.
- B. Despite any other provision in these articles, the corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that do not further the purposes of this corporation, and the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by (a) a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3) or the corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law, or (b) a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Internal Revenue Code section 170(c)(2) or the corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law.

IV.


- A. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of lobbying or propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation; this corporation shall not participate or intervene in (including publishing or distributing statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- B. All corporate property is irrevocably dedicated to the purposes set forth in Article II. No part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any of its directors, officers or members, or to the benefit of any private person.
- C. Upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts, obligations, and liabilities of the corporation, the remaining assets of this corporation shall be distributed to such organization (or organizations) organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational and/or religious purposes which has established its tax-exempt status under Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3) (or corresponding provisions of any future federal internal revenue law).

3. The foregoing amendment and restatement of the Articles of Incorporation has been duly approved by the board of directors.


4. The corporation has no members.
